

## CEO BRYAN NEELY TO RETIRE THIS YEAR

After a long and successful career with the Ontario Provincial Police Association Credit Union (OPPACU), CEO Bryan Neely will retire at the end of 2018.

One of OPPACU's first employees, Bryan has been a major contributor to the credit union's success. He began his career in the Accounting department in 1979 and by 1984, had worked his way up to Assistant General Manager. In this role, he worked closely with the then founder and General Manager to help steer the credit union's early years. Bryan was appointed Chief Executive Officer in 1999 and has provided strategic and dynamic leadership since.

From the beginning, Bryan believed in providing members with value-added advice that would encourage building relationships for life, one member at a time. That philosophy drives the actions of the team he has built and nurtured, and led to a strong and vital credit union, whose assets have grown under Bryan's leadership from \$42 million to over \$200 million.

"It has been rewarding to watch OPPACU build deep and meaningful relationships with our members supporting them to achieve their financial goals, and I know the team will continue to do so under the new CEO," Bryan says.
